

A roof rarely asks for attention in a dramatic way, at least not at first. It does not usually leak the day staining appears. It does not fail the week a few dark streaks show up. Most of the time, it changes slowly. A little discoloration along the north-facing slope. A patch of moss where shade holds moisture. Fine black lines that seem cosmetic until they spread across half the house. A roof in full sun with excellent drainage may stay clean longer. A roof shaded by mature maples or bordered by damp landscaping may need attention far sooner. Experienced technicians look at exposure, slope, surrounding trees, gutter condition, and roofing type before deciding how to clean and how often maintenance should happen.

Homeowners often assume the roof is fine because there is no leak. In practice, visible staining and biological growth are early warnings. They tell you moisture is lingering where it should shed cleanly. The roof may still be structurally sound, but it is already under stress.

Roof cleaning is not the same as pressure washing

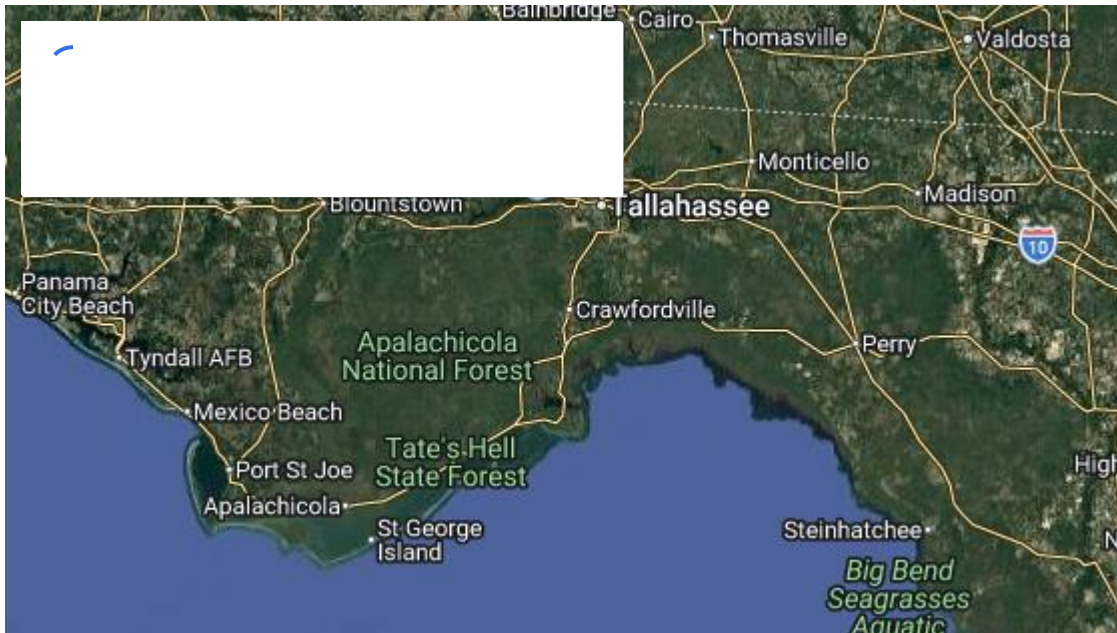
